Anybody who attended the Siva Tour performances during August and September would know that it was simply incredible! The sheer work rate and precision of the dancing was mind blowing! Some of us have been lucky enough to see the young men dancing in Samoa. It was great that they were able to bring their skills, enthusiasm and passion to Australia.

Don Bosco Technical Centre was established and opened in 1989 to offer a "second chance" technical and vocational education to boys and young men who had not succeeded in mainstream schooling and were at risk of remaining untrained and unskilled and thus at risk of suffering a lifetime of unemployment and poverty. More than 25 years later they remain faithful to that mission. Most of the boys are from poor families, have not successfully completed secondary schooling and have had little previous experience of achievement and

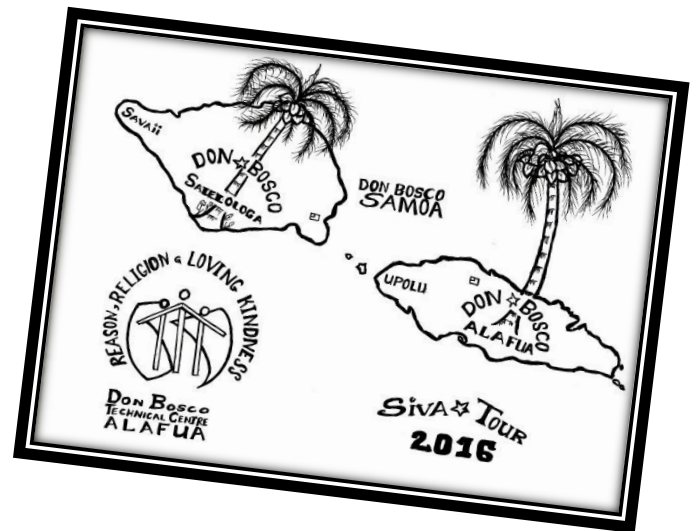
success. This makes the achievement of their tour even more incredible and we are so proud to be associated with such a school.

Fr. Chris Ford expressed thanks to the Cagliero family for their support of the tour:

'We were thrilled at the wonderful reception we received everywhere we visited. The excitement was obvious in each school, parish and other communities. So many people were appreciative of the joy and happiness our boys were able to share through their singing, dancing and performing. We are a poor school but we feel so blessed to have had the opportunity to share what we have with you all'.

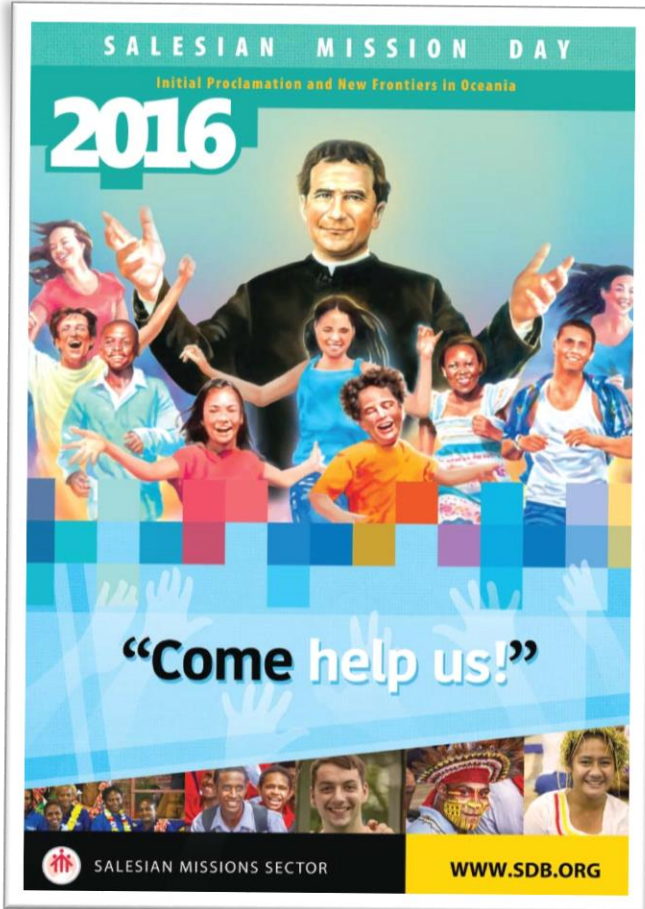


Immersion 2017
